



Chinese Language

Vision

Pupils to be skilled in oral and writing in Chinese, grounded in good character and are appreciative of the Chinese culture

Mission

To provide opportunities for character and Chinese culture to be instilled, equipping pupils to be competent in oral and writing skills.

Di Zi Gui (DZG)
