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5) School Rules - Smart watches

We would like to remind all parents and students that smart watches are <u>not</u> permitted to be brought into the classrooms for all assessments including examinations. This is in line with National Examination practices. Our school has some important rules pertaining to the usage of smart watches. Please refer to page 14 of the Students Handbook 2022 (a copy of which is shown here).

School Rules

8. Smart Watches

8.1. As smart watches can be rather expensive, students are discouraged from wearing smart watches to school. Simple watches that enable telling the time would suffice for primary school students.

- 8.2. If students were to bring smart watches to school, the following rules must be adhered to:
- a) Parents must deactivate the following features:
 - Photo-taking
 - Video and Audio Recordings
- b) In light of PDPA (Personal Data Protection Act), we would like to remind all parents and students that unauthorized usage of these functions will be taken to be flouting PDPA and the school reserves the right to confiscate the smart watch, delete the recording if need be and return it to the parents only after investigations have been completed and after the parents have attended a conference with the School Leaders.
- c) Smart watches are not permitted to be brought into the classrooms for all assessment including examinations. This is in line with National Examination practices.
- d) Smart watches are communication devices and will be treated in the same manner as mobile phones. They can only be used for communication after lessons at the dismissal points (at the gates) so that students can contact their parents or guardians. Parents are not to send messages to the smart phones during curriculum hours as it will be a source of distraction for students in the classrooms.
- e) Any misuse of the smartwatches will result in the confiscation of the device. The smartwatch will be returned after a conference with the parents.

6) Labour Day Holiday (Mon 2 May)

Please take note that Mon 2 May is a public holiday in lieu of Labour Day, which falls on Sun 1 May 2022.

7) Hari Raya Puasa (Tue 3 May)

Hari Raya Puasa falls on Tue 3 May this year. We would like to wish all our Muslim students, parents and staff Selamat Hari Raya Aidilfitri in advance. May the festive season bring much joy to you and your family!
